

GRANTOWN-ON-SPEY CONSERVATION AREA MANAGEMENT PLAN PUBLICATION OF DRAFT GUIDANCE FOR CONSULTATION

The Highland Council has prepared a draft Conservation Area Management Plan (CAMP) for Grantown-on-Spey under Section 63 (1) of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Act 1997. The purpose of the Management Plan is to address the findings of the Conservation Area Appraisal and further consider the Conservation Area's challenges, threats and opportunities. The plan provides strategy and guidance on the management of change and development in the Conservation Area, in order to preserve and enhance its special qualities, and its character and appearance as identified in the appraisal.

Any person wishing to do so may make representations on the content of the draft CAMP and we encourage people to tell us what they think at this stage.
